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Velkommen

Kære kollega,

Bestyrelsen i DSOHH har den glæde at indbyde til selskabets årsmøde på Hotel Nyborg Strand den 3.-4. april 2025. Efter sidste års succesfulde 125-års jubilæumsarrangement vil årets møde følge den velkendte form med et komprimeret, videnskabeligt program af høj faglig kvalitet over to dage.

Årets tema er laryngologi, og vi indleder med foredrag og paneldiskussioner med både internationale og nationale perspektiver om dette. I år har inviteret tre fremtrædende internationale foredragsholdere:

1. Professor Jean-Paul Marie (Frankrig), en pioner inden for laryngeal reinnervation hos børn og voksne patienter med recurrens parese. Han vil holde foredrag om laryngeal reinnervation og larynx transplantation.
2. Professor Se-Heon Kim (Korea) vil præsentere TORS-kirurgi ved hoved-halskræft, baseret på deres betydelige erfaringer. Invitationen udspringer af DSOHH's venskabsforhold med det Koreanske øre-næse-halsselskab, og danske hoved-hals kirurger har tidligere besøgt Korea for at lære af deres ekspertise.
3. Dr. Robert Bodlaj, næse-bihulekirurg fra en privatklinik nord for Nürnberg, vil holde to foredrag om rekonstruktion af concha inferior ved "empty nose syndrom" og søvnapnø.

Vi har modtaget 77 abstracts til årsmødet og har lavet et program med 5 ph.d. forelæsninger, 30 foredrag samt 23 poster. Som sædvanlig vil der være postergennemgang og priser til de bedste foredrag og poster.

Torsdag eftermiddag afholdes generalforsamling, hvor alle medlemmer opfordres til at deltage aktivt og stemme ved valg. Der serveres forfriskninger.

Vores udstillere præsenterer nye og innovative produkter. Vi opfordrer deltagerne til at besøge standene og tale med repræsentanterne.

En stor tak til alle, der har bidraget fagligt og hjulpet med forberedelserne. Vi ser frem til nogle udbytterige dage – både fagligt og socialt.
